Information clause regarding the processing of personal data

The administrator of your personal data is Stalma SA with its registered office in Lublin, ul. Puławska 38, postal code: 20-822.

Your personal data will be processed if necessary:

1. in connection with the response to the Request for Quotation regarding an automatic line for peeling rolled bars submitted by Stalma SA, ul. Puławska 38, 20-822 Lublin;
2. in connection with the performance of the subject of a possible contract;
3. to fulfill the legal obligation imposed on the administrator, in particular to settle the matter in accordance with applicable law;
4. protection of the vital interests of the data subject or another natural person.

Your personal data will be:

1. made available to entities authorized under the law and in accordance with applicable legal provisions;
2. stored for the duration of the case, and then stored for the period and to the extent required in accordance with applicable law. In the absence of such regulations, in the case of personal data processing based on your consent (including voluntary transfer of data by you), personal data will be processed no longer than until you withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data.

In cases, under the terms and conditions specified in applicable regulations, you have the right to:

1. access to the content of the data and rectification thereof;
2. deletion of data (see Article 17 of the GDPR);
3. restrictions on processing (see Article 18 of the GDPR);
4. data transfer - including if your data is processed on the basis of consent (see Article 20 of the GDPR);

5. withdraw consent (if your data is processed on the basis of consent) at any time;
6. object to the processing of your personal data (see Article 21 of the GDPR).

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office. Office of the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (PUODO) ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw.

Providing data, subject to specific legal provisions, is voluntary, but necessary to resolve the matter.

The data will be processed in accordance with the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of April 27, 2016 and the Act of May 10, 2018 on the protection of personal data (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2019, item 1781).
